Upcoming Mars Special Issues Welcoming Paper Submissions

Planetary and Space Science has approved a special issue on "Amazonian Mars: Climate & Processes," with submissions accepted November 1, 2018 to February 28, 2019. Papers that describe the climate history as well as geological and environmental processes that pertain to the Amazonian period of Mars' history, which includes the present-day, are solicited. The Amazonian period encompasses the most recent 3 billion years of Mars history, which has strongly shaped the evolution of the surface that we now observe. This special issue was prompted by the recent Mars Workshop on Amazonian and Present-day Climate (https://www.hou.usra.edu/meetings/amazonian2018/). Submissions are welcome from the community.
